

Making Sentences More Interesting (2)

Sentences can be made more interesting by adding verbs, adjectives and adverbs.

- **Verb** - a doing word (e.g. run, talk, eat)
- **Adjective** - a describing word (e.g. huge, green, polite)
- **Adverb** - a word that describes a verb (e.g. quickly, slowly, happily)
